

RULES FOR FRUIT TREES

- The trees must have a dwarf root stock (e.g. M27, M106 for apples and equivalent for other fruit), preferably trained as Cordon, Espalier or 'stepover'.
- They must not be planted along the boundary of your plot or allowed to overhang any paths. Please ensure that your allotment neighbours are happy with the location of the trees.
- The warden must be advised and confirm the siting of the trees is acceptable.
- Your fruit trees must be well maintained and not allowed to grow in excess of 6' (2 m) in height.
- When you vacate your plot, you should remove the trees. If you do not, they will be offered to the incoming tenant. If he/she does not want them, you will be charged for the cost of removing them.
